Morphine usage varies but in 2017 it averaged 32 patients per month. 11% were for chest pain but over 50% were for trauma and 38% for pain management.

FORESTRY: Grant checks given out at May meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: Helmet decals- options have been presented we all agreed on florescent green to be able to be seen on all helmets. Decals will be round and say St. Clair Certified. A sample policy of how to control the who gets the decals is to be drafted. Tommy with Royal Restoration has offered to cover the cost of the decals.
